**The purpose of the Membership Assistance Program (MAP) Grant is to provide financial assistance to Golf Saskatchewan registered affiliated clubs so they may operate programs encouraging and promoting community and club level sport development in their local area.**





# ELIGIBILITY FOR FUNDING



**Funds will be made available to clubs providing:**

- **Members are in good standing with Golf Saskatchewan**
- **Clubs have no outstanding MAP grant follow-up reports from previous grants received**
- **Clubs have a minimum of 25 Golf Canada/SK members**
- **Clubs publicly acknowledge the financial support received from Saskatchewan Lotteries & Golf Saskatchewan**

# APPLICATION PROCESS



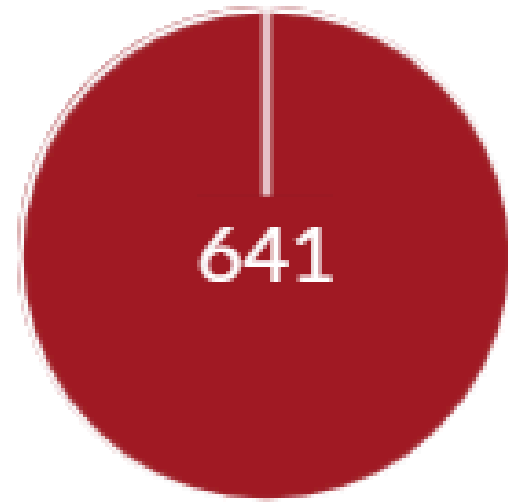
- The MAP Application form can be accessed via the Golf SK website
- Completed applications must be received in the Golf SK office by midnight on June 15
- Late or improperly completed applications may be returned to the applicant
- MAP funding approval amounts will be based on how many Golf Canada/Golf SK members a club has renewed on the Golf Canada Score Centre in the current year



# FUNDING AMOUNTS

- **Member Facilities without Golf SK/Golf Canada Members**
  - **Facilities without any Golf SK/Golf Canada members may not be eligible for MAP funding.**
- **Member Facilities with Golf SK/Golf Canada Members**
  - **Facilities will be eligible for a base amount of funding and will receive additional funding based on the number of paid Golf SK/Golf Canada members in the current year**
- **Member Players Clubs**
  - **Clubs will receive funding based on the number of paid Golf SK/Golf Canada members in the current year**

# How Golf Canada/Golf SK Members are Calculated for MAP Funding

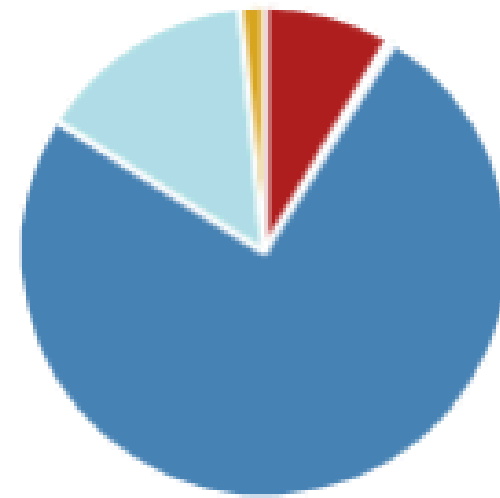

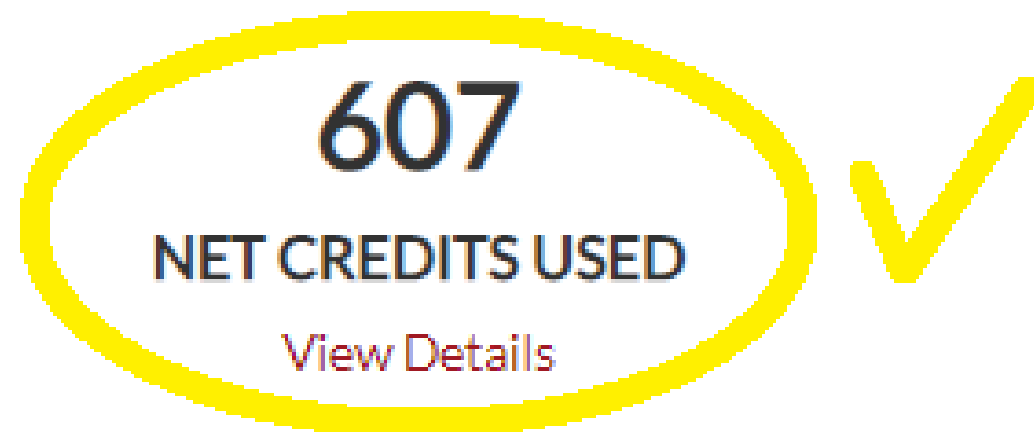

Each club's Score Centre account will be reviewed showing all current renewed members for the year ("Net Credits Used").

This will be used to calculate MAP funding approved for each club

**Example:** In the picture, this club has 641 active accounts but only 607 members renewed for the year. This club will receive MAP grant funding for 607 members. If the club renews more members between June 15<sup>th</sup> and September 15<sup>th</sup>, they will receive MAP grant funding for the additional members in their final payment.

# PAYMENT PROCESS

- **Existing Clubs – a club will be paid 75% of the total approved MAP grant amount within 3 weeks of the MAP grant deadline.**
- **Approved final payments will be made to eligible clubs by October 1st upon submission of the required follow-up report, including appropriate receipts to verify expenditures**
- **Grants will be paid to clubs with the understanding the funds are to be used for the purposes outlined in the approved MAP application & Spending Plan**
- **If a program/service offered by the club changes, please notify the Golf Saskatchewan office.**

# Project Examples - Participation Initiatives



## **Lessons for any age/gender:**

Expenses for hiring PGA of Canada SK Zone Golf Professional or Community Coach (fuel costs, instructor fees, range balls, club rental)



## **Encourage Participation in Competitions - Junior & Women:**

Expenses associated with sending a team from your club to Golf Saskatchewan's Provincial Competitions or Pro Lady/Pro Junior (entry fee, team shirts, team hats, golf bags, hotel, fuel costs)



## **Establish/Grow a Junior program:**

Expenses for shuttle to golf course, hats, shirts, range fees, green fees, purchase of rental clubs



## **Promote Golf to New Canadians & Under-Represented Populations:**

Expenses related to initiating golf programs, encouraging and providing golf opportunities for more females, First Nation and Aboriginal athletes, Northern communities, economically disadvantaged, individuals with physical or cognitive disabilities, new Canadians, refugees.

# Project Examples - Promote Your Golf Facility

**Advertising: leisure guides, magazines, radio, newspapers, websites, Facebook, Tourism Saskatchewan, Google ads**

**Scorecard printing (include Golf Sk logo on the card)**

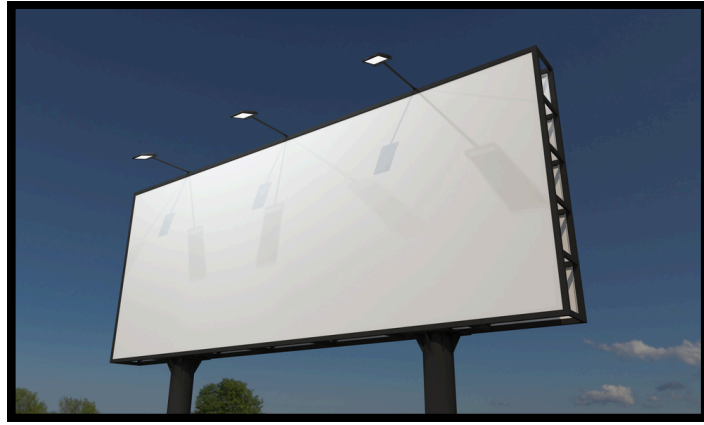
**Course Signage – highway signs, on course signage**

**Hosting costs for your own website**

**Development costs for getting a golf course website started**

**Mail-out to your members or other courses (postage and printing expenses)**

**Tee On, Golf Genius or other online booking and leagues/tournament management software to encourage participation**

AED/First Aid/CPR training and/or purchase of an AED machine

Purchase Rules of Golf books or Rules of Handicapping books for your members

Hold a rules education/course etiquette session for members (expenses for instructor and instructor fuel costs)

# Project Examples - Promote Score Posting

**Monthly Internet rental expenses**

**Purchase of a computer or tablet for members to use for score posting**

**Purchase of a Printer/Toner for printing & posting of reports**

**Prize expenses for score posting contests your facility is running to promote posting scores.**
