Dress Code | Caddie Dress Code | Footwear Policy

- The purpose of this policy is to respect the game of golf and preserve its traditions, while allowing for modern, comfortable, and stylish performance apparel.
- If a host facility has a dress code more restrictive than this policy, the host facility's dress code will take precedence.
- All **players** and **caddies** must follow the Dress Code at all times on the host golf course, including during practice and tournament rounds.
- Participants not in compliance with the Dress Code may be prohibited from teeing off.
- A violation is discovered after play has begun may require the player to discontinue play.

Permitted Attire:

1. **Women*** are permitted to wear pants, slacks, shorts, skorts, capris, yoga pants, and dresses.
 - Mock style, V-neck, sleeveless shirts, or designed untucked tops are permitted.
 - Excessive bare midriff/cleavage is not acceptable or permitted.
2. **Men** are required to wear golf shirts with collars (mock necks/turtlenecks are permitted).
 - Shorts may be worn, including dress golf shorts with a side pocket are acceptable.
 - Kilts are also acceptable.
3. **Caddies** must wear a caddie bib for identification purposes.
4. **Hats/Visors** must be worn in a forward position. ^
 - Please remove your hats/visors when going in the clubhouse.

* Includes transgender and non-binary participants.

^ Hats may be worn backwards in certain instances (such as heavy rain/strong wind).

Prohibited Attire:

1. Clothing with inappropriate graphics, logos, and/or slogans.
2. Provocative clothing – players, spectators, or caddies may be asked to change.
3. Tank tops, plain T-shirts, denim shorts, short shorts, cut-off shorts, gym shorts.
4. Jeans including blue jeans or other coloured denim material.
5. For Junior's – any clothing with alcoholic/marijuana/vaping/tobacco branding.

Permitted Footwear

- Players must always wear appropriate footwear.
- Acceptable options include athletic shoes or shoes equipped with soft spikes **only**.

Prohibited Footwear

- Boots, of any kind.
- Traditional "metal" spike shoes.
- Non-golf sandals, slides, flip-flops, and other open-toed shoes.

Penalties for Non-Compliance:

- 1st breach: Warning issued.
- 2nd breach: 1 stroke penalty
- Repeated violation will result in a penalty of **Disqualification**.
