



# Golf Saskatchewan

## Ties, Playoffs, and Retrogression Policy

---

### Golf Saskatchewan events with National Championship Quota Spots:

- **Sudden Victory (Hole-by-Hole) Playoff:**
  - will be used to decide the following:
    - the **overall champion**, and
    - team positions (Gold/Silver/Bronze), and
    - alternate team spot.
- **Retrogression (a.k.a. the matching of scorecards):**
  - will be used to decide the following:
    - All other ties for **quota spots** and/or spots for nationals.

### Golf Saskatchewan Fun Events:

- **Sudden Victory (Hole-by-Hole) Playoff:**
  - will be used to decide the following:
    - Playoffs for (**Rosebowl** or **Mixed Team**) overall champion.
    - Playoff for (Team Competition of the **Champions Cup**)  
→ a combined two-person team with highest combined point totals.
- **Retrogression (a.k.a. the matching of scorecards):**
  - will be used to decide the following:
    - Ties for Silver/Bronze medal positions.
    - Any other flight prizes.

### Playoff Holes: \*

- The Committee will determine the playoff hole(s), and/or
- The rotation of holes, until a winner is determined.

### **Golf Canada Retrogression Method (2026):**

- All other ties will be determined using the following matching of scorecards:
  - The lowest last 18-hole **TOTAL SCORE/POINTS** completed.
  - If there is still a tie, the lowest last nine holes **TOTAL SCORE/POINTS** of the most recently completed round.
  - If there is still a tie, the lowest last six holes **TOTAL SCORE/POINTS** of the most recently completed round.
  - If there is still a tie, the lowest last three holes **TOTAL SCORE/POINTS** of the most recently completed round.
  - If there is still a tie, the lowest last hole **SCORE/POINTS** of the most recently completed round.
  - If there is still a tie, the above process will be used for the front nine.
  - If there is still a tie, the lowest last 36 (or 54) hole score will be used, and
  - This formula will continue until a winner is determined.
- **NOTE:** In the extreme case of identical scorecards for all days played The Committee reserves the right to use the following:
  - a sudden victory playoff will be used, **or**
  - \* in the case of darkness or weather-related issues, a coin flip.
