



NOTICE TO PLAYERS (NTP)

The Legends Golf Club, Warman Sk | July 7-9, 2026

The NTP supplements the entry form, Local Rules,
Terms of the Competition, and Standard Local Rules for 2026 events.

Play is governed by Rules of Golf (effective January 2023 – USGA/R&A/Golf Canada), the Local Rules and Terms of the Competition for the PGA TOUR AMERICAS competitions and qualifying rounds, and, where applicable, by following Terms and Local Rules. **Local Rules posted or used at the host club or local rule on the host club scorecard do not apply.** Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for breach of a Local Rule or Term is the **General Penalty - Two Strokes.**

1. TEE-MARKERS & WASHROOMS

-  Junior Women U19/U17/U15 – **RED** Tee Markers
-  JR-JR Competition – Thin Golf Saskatchewan Markers (On Fairway/ Tee boxes)
-  Junior Women U13- **YELLOW** Tee Markers
-  Washroom – Hole #6 and Hole #14
-  Junior Men U19/ U17 – **GREEN** Tee Markers
-  Junior Men U15- **WHITE** Tee Markers
-  Junior Men U13- **BRONZE** Tee Markers

2. PACE OF PLAY: Time PAR is 4:35. (2:15 + 2:15 + 5 minutes at the turn)

- a. Fescue/ Rough is very long- If a ball enters and you aren't sure of resting spot- Please **DECLARE** a provisional.

3. DESIGNATED PRACTICE AREA – practice is permitted in the following areas:

- a. Driving Range adjacent to the first tee.
- b. Practice putting green behind #1 tee
- c. Practice chipping greens behind #1 tee
- d. The penalty for practicing on the competition course before or between competition rounds is **disqualification.**

4. OUT OF BOUNDS (OB): is marked by the perimeter fencing or white stakes/posts.

5. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (ACC):

- a. No ACC

6. Integral Object-

- a. Railroad ties in the bunkers on holes 7 & 18 are integral to the course, there is no free relief from them.

7. GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Marked

- a. **Hole 2-** left hand side
- b. **Hole 3-** Left hand side
- c. **Hole 15-** Left of the green/ half of the bunker on left hand side.

8. Waste Area-

- a. **Hole 17-** Red Penalty area in front of the teeing area (right) Waste Area, not at the green, is not a bunker but will be treated with the bunker options (disturbed area or not) with an additional notice for the player. As this is part of the General Area, a player may ground her/his club in this area.

9. TEMPORARY IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS: any Starting or Scoring Tent(s) are Temporary Immovable Obstructions. Model Local Rule F23 is in effect.

10. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO THE PUTTING GREEN: Model Local Rule F-5 is in effect. The player may take relief under Rule 16-1b if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play and is on or within two club-lengths of the putting green, and within two club-lengths of the ball.

11. RED PENALTY AREAS: in the absence of sight lines between stakes or a red line, the grass line will be used as the margin of the Red Penalty Area.

12. DROP ZONES (DZ): No drop zones are listed for this event.

13. EVACUATION PLAY: in the event of a suspension of play for a dangerous situation (signaled by one blast of an air horn), players must stop play immediately and move to the clubhouse asap.

14. SCORING AREA: will be located behind hole #18.

15. PLAYOFF: In the event of a tie for the individual/team championships or medals a hole-by-hole playoff will take place on hole(s) to be determined by The Committee and will be repeated if needed until a winner is declared. See Tie-Breaking Procedure on the Golf Saskatchewan website.
