



NOTICE TO PLAYERS (NTP)

Meadow Lake Golf Course | July 24-26 | 2026

The NTP supplements the entry form, Local Rules,
Terms of the Competition, and Standard Local Rules for 2026 events.

Play is governed by Rules of Golf (effective January 2026 – USGA/R&A/Golf Canada), the Local Rules and Terms of the Competition for the PGA TOUR AMERICAS competitions and qualifying rounds, and, where applicable, by following Terms and Local Rules. **Local Rules posted or used at the host club or local rules on the host club scorecard do not apply.** Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for breach of a Local Rule or Term is the **General Penalty - Two Strokes.**

1. TEE-MARKERS & WASHROOMS

-  Senior Women – **Red**
-  Super Senior/Senior/ Legends Forward
tees (No Nationals)- **Bronze**
-  Senior men (55+) (Nationals) – **Green**

 Washroom –Holes 5, 13, 16.

2. PACE OF PLAY: Time PAR is 4:35. (2:15 + 2:15 + 5 minutes at the turn)

3. DESIGNATED PRACTICE AREA – practice is permitted in the following areas:

- a. Practice putting green beside the 10th tee box, as well as the driving range beside the 9th green.
- b. The penalty for practicing on the competition course before or between competition rounds is **disqualification.**

4. OUT OF BOUNDS (OB): is marked by the perimeter fencing or white stakes/posts.

- a. Holes 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 14, 15 all have OB on left hand side.

5. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (ACC): Play it as it lies and/or 16.1.1 ACC.

- a. Hole 6- 140 yards from green, new sod.
- b. Hole 12- Left of green, sodded area.
- c. Hole 14- Front left-hand side of green.
- d. Hole 15- Boxed right hand side of green.
- e. Hole 11 + 18- No play zone- piles of trees awaiting removal.
- f. Hole 18- Boxed area right, before penalty area.

6. TEMPORARY IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS: any Starting or Scoring Tent(s) are Temporary Immovable Obstructions. Model Local Rule F23 is in effect.

7. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO THE PUTTING GREEN: Model Local Rule F-5 is in effect. The player may take relief under Rule 16-1b if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play and is on or within two club-lengths of the putting green, and within two club-lengths of the ball.

- a. **Hole 18-** Ties on left hand side.

8. RED PENALTY AREAS: in the absence of sight lines between stakes or a red line, the grass line will be used as the margin of the Red Penalty Area.

9. DROP ZONES (DZ): No drop zones are listed for this event.

10. EVACUATION PLAY: in the event of a suspension of play for a dangerous situation (signaled by one blast of an air horn), players must stop play immediately and move to the clubhouse asap.

11. SCORING AREA: Will be behind hole 18. Stop by to sign and turn in scorecards.

12. SCORECARD RESPONSIBILITIES

- a. **Scorecard Returned** – The scorecard of a player or a side is returned to the Committee 15 minutes after the scorecard is accepted into the electronic scoring system. See Supplemental Notice to Players for all relevant information.
- b. **Missing Player or Marker Certification** – Model Local Rule L-1 is in effect and Rule 3.3b(2) is modified as follows – If a player returns a scorecard without the hole scores being certified either by the player, the marker or both, the player gets the General Penalty. The penalty applies to the last hole of the player's round.

13. PLAYOFF: In the event of a tie for the individual/team championships or medals a hole-by-hole playoff will take place on hole(s) to be determined by The Committee and will be repeated if needed until a winner is declared. See Tie-Breaking Procedure on the Golf Saskatchewan website.
